Since 1965, Boy Scout Troop 927 has been serving the Westchester community. Currently, there are over 70 Scouts participating in our scouting program.

The Boy Scouts of America have national standards and guidelines that each troop is required to follow. These standards are outlined in the Boy Scout Handbook. **However, each troop achieves its goals in different ways, depending on its members and leaders. Therefore, each Boy Scout program is the same but unique because it is a reflection of the leadership and the community it serves.**

Serving the Community

Giving back to the community is not optional; it is required as a Boy Scout and as a member of the Troop. Through various events and Eagle projects, the Troop has performed services that have benefited our schools, churches, libraries, and parks.

There is an inherent trust that is associated with the Boy Scouts and it is the responsibility of each Scout to validate that trust within the community. Troop Activities

Troop Meetings

The Troop meets three times a month; the first three Mondays of each month. We meet in Westminster Hall at Covenant Presbyterian Church located at 6323 W. 80th St. on the corner of Sepulveda Blvd. and 80th Street. Meetings begin at 7:00 pm and end at 8:30pm. Scouts are required to attend in uniform. Parent meetings are on the fourth Monday of each month at 7:00 pm in Westminster Hall. All parents are encouraged to attend.

Registration for New Scouts

The annual registration fee is \$50, due in December. The fee for new Scouts coming from a Cub Scout Pack or BSA Troop is \$25. All new scouts receive a Troop 927 neckerchief, the Boy Scout Handbook and a Troop t-shirt.
